Treasurer Report: Balance is \$101,530.20. Merchant account balance is \$7,235.33. PayPal account balance is \$1,482.00. Darrell paid Walker \$15,192.00 for the drag. **Jim Hannemann motions to accept Treasurer report, Brian Weinkauf seconds. Motion carries.**

Trail Boss:

- Saturday's cleanup and trail maintenance day went well. We had 18 people show up to brush and sign the trails from 310 Rd to the Lazy Ace.
- The Arrowhead drag is paid for.
- The Ultimate drag should be here by the first week of October

President's Report:

- Hank is working with the Rec Council to help with representation for the Mercer Snogoers. He met with the President and Secretary of the AWSC to help implement some sort of representation on our club's behalf.
- The town of Mercer covered the entire gravel bill for the ATV club.

- Hank won't sign the trail contract yet. He wants to renegotiate parts of it.

Vice President's Report: We paid 50% of the \$2,239 gravel bill from Altman and the ATV club paid the other 50% of the bill for trail maintenance on trail 12a between Hwy FF and Beaver's Resort.

Directors Reports: No report.

Items for Discussion/Possible Action:

- Winter Blast – We hired the Black Whiskey Creek Band for the Winter Blast. Tanner needs volunteers. He doesn't know if the Harvest Group will help this year. Tanner would also like to see the Vintage Sled show return again this year and needs someone to run it.
- Summer Raffle – ticket sales are very low. We sold 34 of the 250 tickets so far. We will check into whether we can scan and send ticket stubs through email.
- Winter Raffle – the snowmobile is being moved around to different business to show what people can win.
- Public Comment – Luke Schlueter suggested maybe doing an all you can eat wrist band.
- If anyone wants something added to the agenda, they will have to bring it up during the Public Comment portion of the meeting and then that item will be added to the next month's agenda.
